Evaluation Information

Audition Choreography Date

Monday, June 1

- Choreography time is assigned based on age.
- Participants must attend this choreography session to audition.

Evaluation Process

- On Monday, June 1, dancers will learn 4- 6 eight counts of choreography which will contain movement and technical skills for pom, jazz & hip hop (dependent upon styles for which dancers are auditioning).
- Dancers will be assigned to call-back groups for Tuesday, June 2. The times will be emailed to each family no later than 10:00pm on Monday, June 1.
- Dancers must attend call-back time on Tuesday, June 2.
- Official team placements and rehearsal days/times will be announced via email no later Thursday, June 4.
- Official rehearsal will begin on Saturday, June 6. Commitment agreement is due on Monday, June 8.

Group Placement

Age Requirements and Teams

In order to be eligible, dancers must meet the age requirements set forth by the USASF. Age requirements are based on birth year. Athletes must be born on or between the dates listed under "Eligibility by Birth Year" in order to be eligible for the corresponding division.

The age categories are as follows:

Peak Athletics competes in the Pom, Hip Hop, Jazz & Contemporary/Lyrical divisions. Upon registering you will indicate how many routines in which your dancer wishes to compete. Pricing is dependent on the number of routines in which your dancer competes (see page 4).

Commitment Agreement

Following team announcements, dancers and parents are required to sign the Peak Commitment Agreement for the 2020 - 2021 dance season. By signing this agreement, dancers are accepting a position in the Peak Athletics All Star Elite Dance program, and both the parents and dancers are committing to the expectations required of being on a Peak competitive dance team. Dancers and parents will have until June 8, to complete the commitment agreements.

Financial Responsibilities & Obligations

Thank you for your careful consideration of the financial commitment involved with participation in our program! At Peak Athletics, we are upfront with our costs. We have an all-inclusive monthly price that covers most of the costs your dancer will incur throughout the season. This all-inclusive monthly price includes all team tuition, required classes and fees associated with being a part of a team. These fees are added and divided equally among the 11 months of our season and will be billed monthly. You will be assessed monthly Team Tuition charges June 2020 - April 2021. Once your dancer has been placed in our competitive program, your family is financially committing to the 11-month season.

Please note: Team Fees are non-refundable for ANY reason.

Payment : All team families are required to have a credit card on file for the upcoming season. This credit card will be used for ALL payments including tuition, team fees, costumes, annual membership and travel. Each family has the ability to pay prior to all due dates with any form of payment. For tuition and team fees, your card will be charged on the 26th of each month. All other payments will be processed on or after the due date specified on your monthly statement. In the event your credit card is declined, a new/valid card must be placed on file immediately. Past due charges are subject to late fees.

Additional Fees

Costumes : Each dancer is required to purchase a costume for each routine. Costumes will include, but are not limited to, hair accessories, undergarments, embellishments and any additional associated items. Hip Hop routines will include shoes, Pom, Jazz, Lyrical/Contemporary and Variety costumes do NOT include shoes. Costumes will not exceed \$300/routine. The costume fee will be assessed to each dancers' account AFTER choreography is completed and will be due within one month of the assessment date.

Required Uniform items : Each dancer is required to purchase the following items: Peak Warm Up Jacket (same as last season), team leggings (same as last year), earrings, makeup kit, backpack (same as last season) and team sneakers. The total for these items will not exceed \$300 and is due on August 25, 2020.

Costumes and all associated items and accessories are non-refundable for ANY reason.

Membership Fee : An annual membership fee of \$50 per athlete or \$75 per family will be assessed on each family's anniversary date and charged to your credit card on file.

TUITION & TEAM FEES (JUNE 2020 - APRIL 2021)

The number of routines a dancer participates in determines their monthly tuition costs. The costs below include team tuition, team tumbling, team technique classes, training classes and fees associated with being part of an All Star team.

3 Routines : \$580/month	Practice time : 8 hours/week

Additional Classes

Team dancers are offered an extremely discounted tuition rate for any additional classes taken after their required classes. Each additional class will be offered at a 50% discount.

Travel Expenses :

All Mini, Youth, Junior & Senior Non-Worlds teams will travel to ONE National Competition. The dates for National Travel will be released in September. There will be fees associated with this event and more details will be provided in September.



The Dance Summit :

All Mini, Youth, Junior & Senior Non-Worlds teams are eligible to receive Bids to The Dance Summit. The Dance Summit is an all-levels end of season event held in May 2021 at Walt Disney World in Orlando, Florida. Each team will have 2 - 3 opportunities to earn Bids to The Dance Summit.

Discounts :

- Peak offers a \$50 per month tuition discount for each additional sibling in the All Star Elite Dance Program.
- Peak offers a 5% tuition discount to families who choose to pay the full season's tuition in full by June 25.
- Do you know someone interested in All Star Elite Dance at Peak? Receive a \$100 account credit if they are evaluated and sign a commitment statement.

Fundraising and Scholarship Opportunities

Peak is proud to offer scholarship opportunities and a strong fundraising program to help offset costs for those wishing to participate.

Peak Booster Club: The Peak Booster Club offers families an opportunity to offset expenses with fundraising efforts.

Kristi Cutright Scholarship: The Peak Booster Club is proud to offer a scholarship opportunity to athletes based on an application and selection process. This opportunity is available in late fall.

Loyalty Program: Each graduating high school senior is eligible to receive \$150 for every consecutive year in Peak's competitive program after two consecutive years. These funds are intended to cover tuition expenses and will be paid directly to their school upon receipt of invoices. Please see Program Director for further details.
