Evaluation Information

Athlete evaluations will take place on Sunday, August 12, 2018. All evaluated athletes will be placed on a team. When you submit your **NEW** online Evaluation registration, you will select a 45 minute block of time to bring your athlete in to be evaluated by our coaching staff. Once evaluations have been completed, team placements will be sent out via email in the following days along with practice times.

Registration Information

NEW THIS YEAR: EVALUATION REGISTRATION AND EVALUATION SCHEDULING WILL BE ONLINE! Visit bit.ly/PeakNoviceCheer to register for a time slot. Registration for Evaluations opens July 23 and will remain open until August 12 after which time a private evaluation will need to be scheduled.

Time Commitment

- The 18-19 Novice season will run from August 2018 to March 2019
- Athletes will attend practice once a week on Sundays for one and a half hours
- First practice will be August 19, 2018.
- All Novice athletes will receive one Rec Tumbling Class at a discounted rate of 50% off Session Tuition (registration for these classes must be done through our Tumbling Director, Jordan Howard, at: jhoward@PeakAthletics.net once teams have been announced)
- Athletes should plan to attend an additional practice the week leading up to a performance
- All Novice athletes will perform at four to six local events beginning in October 2018
- Additional time commitments could include, but are not limited to, dress rehearsals, team bonding events, team photos and the end of season banquet

Financial Obligations

Thank you for your careful consideration of the financial commitment involved with participating in our Competitive Novice Cheer Program. At Peak Athletics, we are upfront with our costs. We have an “all-inclusive” monthly price that covers the expenses that the athlete will normally incur throughout the year. Your monthly fees will be made of “Team Tuition” and “Team Fees.” Team tuition covers practice time. Team fees cover performance entry fees, support staff, banquet, team photos, music, USASF membership and various other expenses. Team fees are non-refundable for any reason. All Peak families are required to pay the yearly registration fee of \$50 per athlete or \$75 per family.

Monthly Fees:

\$150/month

- \$55/month tuition and \$95/month team fees

Payment

All Novice Cheer families are required to have a credit card on file for the upcoming Novice Cheer season. This credit card will be used to pay for all team tuition, team fees, and team uniforms. Each family can pay prior to all due dates with any form of payment. For team tuition and team fees, your card will be charged on approximately the 25th of each month.

Uniforms

Novice teams will perform in a custom Varsity All Star tank top and shorts. In an effort to remain cost-effective, we will be utilizing the same black and gray practice tank from last season for practice again this season. All athletes will be required to purchase our program black cheer shoes and performance bow. A warm up jacket, backpack and make up will be available to purchase as optional items.

The **total cost** for all required items (performance outfit, shoes, bow and practice tank) will not exceed **\$275** before tax and shipping. Uniforms and all related accessories are non-refundable for any reason. 50% of the cost of total order will be due at the time of the uniform fitting in September (exact date and time TBD) and the remaining balance will be due October 25, 2018.
